Caller 1: What do you mean?

James: Google it.

athletic, handsome, does not cry, and are frequently given privileges...

James: Yep.

Ben: That's not how I remember you...

James: How do you remember me, then?

Ben: You just sat doing nothing all day. You were insipid.

James: Oh no, no, no. I was just really bored, that's all.

Dan: Bored all day?

James: What can I say, I just found school to be dull.

Ben: What did you do when at home, then?

James: More or less the same thing...

Ben: Ok.

Caller 1: To be clear, were you a jock or insipid?

James: I was a jock! Stop saying I don't taste of anything!

Ben: Ok, any other questions?

(A phone rings)

Caller 2: Hi. What are your main hobbies, James?

Dan: Oh God.

Ben: Well at least THAT'S true.

James: Yes, it really is more of a passion than a hobby. A way of life.

Caller 2: Why?

Dan: It's because he's strange.

James: It's not because I'm strange, it's because... Errr...

Dan: You're an asshole?

James: No...

Dan: It's because you're an idiot?

James: Next question.

(A phone rings)

Caller 3: Why aren't you in a mental home?

James: I ditched the pink wedding dress so now psychiatrists don't know what I'm dressed in anymore, and can't find me.

Dan: Yes, it should be pointed out that James is now wearing a huge, novelty, foam hand. His head is sticking out of one of the fingers. His feet are sticking out of the palm of the hand... He has to waddle everywhere to move.

James: Again, not because I'm strange, but to avoid capture.

Dan: Even though it does SOUND strange.

James: Right.

Ben: And of course the way you are dressed is certainly not insipid!

James: Right, thank you!

Caller 3: Where did you get it?

James: Well, I have no money as you know, so I had to steal it.

Dan: James, did you steal it whilst wearing your pink wedding dress?

James: It was my only option.

Dan: James, I'm being serious. You surely know the stories that are surely being told about you?
